Students must plan on attending a college or university in the state of Texas and must remain in the engineering program.

## Available Scholarships:

Three (3) \$3,000 one-time scholarship is available for colleges within the State of Texas and Oklahoma

- \* Scholarship funds will be paid in the Fall of 2024.
- \* Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. *TSPE Preston Trail Chapter strongly suggests that each College or university present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines.* The application deadline is <u>June 14th, 2024</u>, by 5:00 p.m (CT). to be received. Any application after the deadline will not be considered.

The applications will be reviewed, and recipients will be selected by a committee from TSPE Preston Trail Chapter. The scholarships will be awarded in July 2024 TSPE Board Meeting. Winning recipients will be contacted directly through the email provided in the application.
